since August 2014 when Martin Thaulow decided to engaged in the Refugee Crisis and work with the related issues he has been traveling intensely to photograph, film and document displaced people and their situation. This has let to more than 50 journeys from Helsinki to Baghdad during this period. He works both as a fine art photographer as well as a photojournalist. The work produced is often used in multiple purposes e.g. in exhibitions, magazines, as campaign material for NGO's, support related to refugees as well as educational/informartional uses.

Since 2015 Martin has been a member of DJ, The Danish Union of Journalists.

In 2018 he was DRC HEAT certified (HAZARDOUS ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS TRAINING) Enabeling him to work with and for organisations in conflict areas and war zones.
